A Special Meeting of the Aransas Pass City Council was held on Monday, October 8, 2018 in the Aransas Pass City Hall, 600 W. Cleveland Blvd., Aransas Pass, Texas 78336. A notice of the meeting was posted 72 hours in advance in accordance with Section 551, Texas Government Code. Mayor Ramiro Gomez, and Council Members Vickie Abrego and Janet Moore; Billy Ellis and Carrie Scruggs were absent. Also present was City Manager Gary Edwards.

1. **CALL MEETING TO ORDER.**

Mayor Gomez called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

2. **CITY MANAGER.**

2.1. Consider and Act on request from Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce for use of Shrimporee Grounds on November 2-4, 2018 for a "Back to Business Recovery Concert" with a Carnival on Sunday.


Mr. Edwards stated that this requests is for use of the Shrimporee Grounds for November 2-4, 2018 for a concert event. Rosemary Vega, Executive Director for the Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce stated that this event is being organized by the Aransas Pass Chamber of Commerce and includes the following local chambers: Aransas Pass, Portland, Port Aransas, Ingleside, Rockport-Fulton, and Corpus Christi. Ms. Vega stated a press conference is planned to announce the event and marketing will begin next week.

Council Member Abrego asked if there are any expenses being incurred by the city, and Ms. Vega responded that police protection is covered through the budget but may ask each city for a contribution. Council Member Moore asked if Aransas Pass was picking up additional expenses than any other Chamber because it is being hosted in Aransas Pass, and Ms. Vega responded no. Mayor Gomez asked if there are hotel motel funds available for advertising, and Mr. Edwards responded that there are funds but they would need to follow the process for requesting those funds.


A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve Item 2.1, seconded by Council Member Abrego, and the motion passed with the following vote: Gomez, Abrego and Moore voting Aye; Ellis and Scruggs were absent.

3. **ADJOURNMENT.**

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Gomez adjourned the meeting at 12:15 pm.
